## 1. POLICY

1.1 This policy addresses the guidelines that should be followed while carrying out Anatomy Lab work

## 2. SCOPE

2.1 The guidelines apply to all veterinary students, faculty and technicians

## 3. PROCEDURE

Students are required to wear long-sleeved white lab coat, gloves and covered or “close-toed” shoes.

All sharps (needles and scalpel blades) are to be disposed of **ONLY** in the sharps container in the Lab. **NEVER** place these two or similar items in the trash bins. Trash bins throughout the Lab are for all non-sharp and **NON-BIOLOGICAL** disposables. Biological disposal bins are in the rear of the Lab near the cooler; and all animal parts are to be placed therein. Buckets under the dissecting tables are for body and embalming **FLUIDS** only. Refrain from placing paper or gloves in there. There are a first-aid-kit and an emergency shower/eyewash in the back of the Lab.

At the end of each lab, each group will be responsible for policing their area, picking up gloves and other trash, cleaning their tables and **STACKING** all **CHAIRS** in the tables so that the floors can be cleaned.

**FOOD, DRINK** and **TOBACCO** (of any kind) are **STRICTLY PROHIBITED** at any time as the area may be contaminated with pathogens.
